RESOLUTION NO: 10- 10

A Resolution adopting the E-Cycle Wisconsin Program

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's electronics recycling law was signed by Governor Doyle in October 2009 as Act 50, the law establishes a statewide program now called the E-Cycle Wisconsin Program; and

WHEREAS, the E-Cycle Wisconsin Program also bans certain residential and business electronics from Wisconsin landfills and incineration effective September 1, 2010 such as Covered Electronic Devices (CEDs) and Eligible Electronic Devices (EEDs) such as computers, monitors, TV and other video display devices, fax machines, DVD and VRC players, printers, and cell phones; and

WHEREAS, as a local government responsible unit (RU), as described under the state recycling law, it is required that the RU provide electronics recycling outreach, and

WHEREAS, manufacturers are now responsible for collecting and recycling those electronics from households and schools. Computers, computer accessories, televisions, cell phones, and other electronics contain harmful materials including lead, mercury, cadmium, other heavy metals, and chemical flame retardants. When disposed of illegally, these chemicals can leach into the environment where they may affect human and environmental health.
