# 2018 Yard Waste/Loose Leaves Schedule

## Collection Notes

- 1) Have materials out on first day of collection by 7am. Crews will pass each home once.
- 2) Yard waste/leaves should be placed at the edge of the roadway, away from mailboxes and other objects.
- 3) Combine all like materials into one pile per property (do not mix leaves with yard waste). Multiple piles per property will not be collected.
- 4) Brush pile limit is 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high and branches must be less than 5' long. Piles in excess of this require a special pickup.
- 5) Crews will not collect contractor generated yard waste.

### Yard Waste Collection

**Loose Yard Waste Collection:** Loose yard waste will start on the second Monday of the month. Large yard waste and branches as well as smaller bagged items will be collected throughout the Village on each week indicated in **RED**. Please only put yard waste out the week of your scheduled pickup. Residents can bring yard waste, recycling, electronics, and scrap metal to **Drop-Off Days** and larger **Clean-Up Days**. Bagged leaves will be collected with yard waste collection, not loose leaf collection. Plastic bags will not be accepted, only biodegradable bags.

### Bagged Yard Waste Collection

**Bagged Yard Waste Collection:** Only bagged yard waste materials and small yard waste containers will be collected on weeks indicated in **PURPLE**. Large piles and branches will not be collected on this week.

### Drop-Off Day

**Drop-Off Days:** Drop-Off Days will be held on the third Saturday of the month. Yard waste, recycling, electronics, and scrap metal may be dropped off in the Department of Public Works parking lot from 9-11:30am. Please enter off of Fairy Chasm.

### Loose Leaf Collection

**Loose Leaf Collection:** Please have one leaf pile per home which is free of other yard waste. Leaf piles should be sufficiently far away from mailboxes or other objects.

### Clean-Up Day

**Clean-Up Days:** Held in the Spring and Fall from 9am-12:00pm in the Department of Public Works parking lot. Drop off waste, recycling and donations in the DPW parking lot (enter off Fairy Chasm). Residents must bring three canned goods or a monetary donation for the sponsored charity to participate.
